

# UNITS ON OFFER

## Semester 2, 2011 and Semester 3, 2011



This information is made available to current and prospective students to assist with the selection of units in Semester 2, 2011 (2011S2) and Semester 3, 2011 (2011S3). Christian Heritage College reserves the right to remove units from offer without notice, in which case other arrangements will be made.

All units carry 10 credit points unless otherwise stated.

A standard full time load for students who are *commencing* an undergraduate Education course (including students who are *transferring* to another course) is 8 units (80 credit points) per year, or 4 units (40 credit points) in each of Semesters 1 and 2, where each unit has an EFTSL value of 0.125.

A standard full time load for students who are *continuing* in an undergraduate Education course is 10 units (100 credit points) in a year, or 5 units (50 credit points) in each of Semesters 1 and 2, where each unit has an EFTSL value of 0.1.

A standard full time load in all other courses is 8 units (80 credit points) in a year, or 4 units (40 credit points) in each of Semesters 1 and 2, where each unit has an EFTSL value of 0.125.

Please refer to the School Student Handbook for information regarding prerequisite requirements for the units being offered, and for information regarding the *Internal*, *Intensive* and *External* modes of study.

The 2011S2 and 2011S3 Unit Selection Forms indicate the dates on which classes are scheduled for units that are offered in the *Intensive* mode. Please note that the dates given for each unit are inclusive and do not represent options for attendance. Students are to attend all of the dates indicated for individual units.

Some units offered by Christian Heritage College may be subject to quotas. Information regarding quotas will appear on the relevant Unit Selection Form in which the particular unit or units to which the quotas apply are offered.

Students at Christian Heritage College are enrolled in either Full-fee paying places or in Commonwealth supported places. Students in Full-fee paying places pay *Tuition fees*, while students in Commonwealth supported places pay a *Student contribution amount*. Commonwealth supported places are available to eligible students in the School of Education and Humanities only. Upfront discounts apply to Student contribution amounts only.

Unit costs for students in Commonwealth supported places vary according to each unit's particular field of study, with similar fields of study being grouped into Bands. The Bands into which units have been classified by the Commonwealth government are indicated in this document. For further information regarding the costs of units to Commonwealth supported students, please refer to the *EFTSL Values for Units of Study for 2011* information sheet, or to page 13 of this document.

The Tuition fee amounts indicate the costs of a unit to Full-fee paying domestic students and to Full-fee-paying overseas students. For further information, please refer to the *2011 Fees and Charges* information sheet. Upfront discounts do not apply to Tuition fees.

The Census Date for each semester is the date on which all enrolment details become final. For further information, please refer to the *Census Dates* information sheet. The 2011 Census Dates are:

- Semester 1, 2011 - Monday, 21 March 2011
- Semester 2, 2011 - Monday, 15 August 2011
- Semester 3, 2011 (Summer) - Friday, 16 December 2011

## INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS IN COMMONWEALTH SUPPORTED PLACES

### Student contribution amounts for 2011

The Commonwealth Government sets a minimum price for student contribution amounts and institutions are able to set their rates within certain ranges. The **student contribution amount** varies depending upon the discipline category of the courses studied, and the year in which a student enrolled in a course of study. Courses are grouped into seven funding clusters. Christian Heritage College offers courses in three of these clusters, which are shown in the table below. These amounts correlate to 1 EFTSL of study. For further information regarding EFTSLs, please consult the *EFTSL Values For Units of Study for 2011* information sheet.

Subject to residency eligibility requirements, students who make upfront payments of \$500 or more, or the total student contribution amount, attract a 20% discount.
